Nominations for Election of Officers

August is "*Nominating Month*" for the Society. These are the positions of officers expiring this year:

Vice-President- creates and presents or arranges for presenters for 6 membership meetings

Membership Secretary- maintains membership records

Secretary- keeps minutes for all meetings

Treasurer- keeps financial records for the Society

Trustee#1- is responsible for writing the newsletter and auditing financial records

Trustee#2- is in charge of publicity and auditing financial records

Librarian- organizes, documents, and maintains records of the Society's collections.

Each position is a two-year term. Members in good standing (dues are current) may nominate a member in good standing for one of the positions.
